Black and Indian Mission reaches out to those who seek Christ in what is often a hostile environment. Approximately half of the funds collected are returned to our archdiocese for

grants to assist local projects and initiatives, such as the Congregation of the Great Spirit and the Black Catholic Ministry.

Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) confronts the causes of poverty, rather than merely treating its symptoms. With the archbishop's approval, CCHD makes both national and local grants each year to create jobs, improve education and strengthen neighborhoods.

Catholic University of America is the national university of the Catholic Church. This collection underwrites scholarships to assist financially deserving students in completing their education, including many who come from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee.
