#### Welcome to GIFT!

#### What is GIFT?

- GIFT is:" Generations in Faith Together"
- An Innovative Approach to faith formation for everyone!!
- **GIFT IS OUR PROGRAM OF FAITH FORMATION**
- It is a true Intergenerational learning experience as singles, seniors, couples and families/households of all varieties and forms gather to grow in faith together.

We gather 10 times per year, between September and April, approximately every 3 weeks Our Gatherings include:

- ▲ A delicious Prepared Meal so we can relax, eat together, and socialize:
- An Opening Experience that is an introduction to the theme of the session.
- Learning Sessions on the topic that are age appropriate
- A brief closing activity that takes a variety of forms

#### Why GIFT?

The answer to this question is really a series of questions:

- How might we offer Catholic Christians a method of faith formation that speaks to both their lives and the world we live in?
- How can we walk with those people who desire to be the Light of Christ in their communities?
- How do we help strengthen those who still feel that faith is a priority, but struggle in commitment?
- How do we make sense of all that is part and parcel of Catholicism?
- How can we live our faith and grow in it in the day to day of family life, jobs, etc.?
- How can we create a "norm" for living the Gospel message? Or, for even simply talking about God and praying in our homes?

#### When is GIFT??

- GIFT takes place about every 3 to 4 weeks from September through April
- You would choose to come on a Sunday after the 10:30 Liturgy (about 11:45am) and expect to stay until 2:15pm OR come Monday evening at 5:30pm until about 8:15pm
- Households with school aged children:
  - Our expectation is that you will be in attendance the entire 10 sessions each year.

    IF YOUR CHILD IS PREPARING FOR THE SACRAMENTS, YOU WILL ALSO PARTICIPATE IN A
  - SEPARATE PREPARATION PROGRAM
- Households without school aged children have the option of signing up for Individual sessions.

#### How Much does GIFT cost?

- Meals, Sacrament Prep materials, and all supplies are included in the tuition fee
- Fees vary according to the size of the household
- There is a discount for Seniors!

- Payments can be made in full or quarterly; Tuition scholarships are also available
