The Archdiocese of Milwaukee requires that all children who wish to prepare for a sacrament must have actively participated in a Faith Formation program the year of and prior to receiving the sacrament.

What does that mean at Our Lady of Lourdes?

If your child and you have faithfully attended our GIFT program* when your child was in first grade, then he/she is invited to join us in Sacrament preparation this upcoming Fall 2015 and Spring 2016.

If you have not been a part of this program (or a program at another parish or in a Catholic school) then we invite you to join us for GIFT this year. Your child would then participate in Sacrament preparation *in the THIRD Grade***.

<u>In addition</u> to the Sacrament Preparation meetings, regular attendance and participation is required in the GIFT program.
