#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

#### Dear fellow parishioners,

On September 1st of this year, when Bishop Richard Sklba dedicated our new altar and ambo he made this statement, "This is a very beautiful church--and the building is very nice also." To help us experience the reality, he invited all of us to step forward and reverence both the altar and the ambo in our own way. He captured the vision of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish. For we, the people, are the church, and our gathering together continues our growth as a community of Jesus' disciples.

Keep our Vision Growing is our call, as the people of God, which demands that we expand our love of God, grow in our love of neighbor, and carry out our responsibility to serve others in need. In other words, we need to grow in spirituality, community and ministry. We gather to grow spiritually through

our prayers, our song, our celebration of sacraments and our liturgy. We gather together in our study, our work and our fun to become better known to each other as brothers and sisters in Christ. We gather together to explore the needs of the community around us and to find the gifts we have to respond in ministry.

To keep the vision growing, our parish needs the facilities that support who we are and who we are becoming. We gather as the people of God most often to grow spiritually in our worship space. We have renovated the space to celebrate our spirit but the costs have not been entirely covered. We hope to improve the space for music ministry and offer greater access to those of us who are limited physically. Our parish hall is our largest and most often used gathering place for study, for meeting, for food and for having fun. We need to update and refresh this environment to be more who we are. And finally, to gather people in

and be hospitable and minister together, our marquee and directional signage need to be improved and updated.

Together we can keep the vision growing by sacrificing a little extra. Yes, we are "a very beautiful church--and the buildings are very nice also." Together we will continue to grow spiritually as a community ministering to others. I pray that you will join me in this effort. I am your brother,

### Our mission

#### SHARING TOGETHER

The *Keep Our Vision Growing* Appeal is a parish-wide effort to renew and expand our financial support of the parish in two key areas:

#### Our Regular Weekly/Monthly Offerings

Our regular offerings are needed to support our ministries and parish expenses for 2013. Your generous weekly/monthly offerings pay for:

- Parish staff salaries and payroll expenses/benefits.
- Operating expenses (heat, electricity, phone, office supplies, etc.)
- Ministry needs (sacramental supplies, music, formation needs, etc.)

Our goal is to increase regular weekly/monthly offerings by 2% to 3%. Please respond with your commitment for 2013 by returning the enclosed Regular Weekly/Monthly Offering commitment card.

#### Capital Fund Giving

Our earlier planning process and needs assessment relied upon input from our parishioners. This input led to prioritized recommendations that parishioners felt were important to our future. We now seek special threeyear commitments, over and above our regular weekly/monthly offerings, to:

- Fully fund and complete our worship space renovations (\$265,000)
- Renovate our parish hall (\$90,000)
- Enhance our outdoor signage (\$20,000)

Our goal is to raise as much of the proposed renovation project costs as possible in three-year commitments. Please respond with your 3-year commitment to our Capital Fund by returning the enclosed Capital Fund commitment card.

# OUR RENOVATION PLANS

#### **Worship Space Renovations**

We are excited about the progress that has been made with our worship space renovations. The final phase of our worship space renovations, estimated to cost \$125,000, includes the following:

- Choir Platform Reconfiguration with accessibility
- Wall Aesthetic Enhancements on East, South & West walls
- · Stations Of The Cross on South wall

- · Ambry (holder of sacred oils)
- Candle Stands, Credence Table, Chairs for Presider & Servers
- · Organ Cabinet Removal
- Relocation of bas reliefs (sculptured art)


Our parishioners have been generous in their support of the renovations we currently enjoy. These renovations were also funded by "lending ourselves" or "advancing " roughly \$140,000 from the proceeds of the sale of our rectory, which was to originally assist us in maintaining a healthy reserve for unforeseen repairs. One of our goals is to use a portion of our Capital Fund gifts to "pay ourselves back" by restoring \$140,000 to our parish reserves.

#### **Parish Hall Renovations**

Our Parish Hall is an important space in the life of our parish. Proposed renovations, estimated to cost \$90,000, would include:

- Rebuilding of outside walls for energy efficiency and resolve moisture issues
- · Replacing lighting for energy efficiency
- Installing a new audio/visual system
- Replacing acoustical ceiling











### THE INVITATION TO GIVE

#### Capital Fund Giving

All members of our parish family are asked to pray and consider the following invitation to give to our Capital Fund.

#### **Matching Existing Giving**

We ask you to pray and consider matching (doubling) your current regular giving over the next three years. For example, if your current regular giving is \$15 per week (\$780 a year), would you pray and consider giving an additional \$15 per week to our Capital Fund over the next three years, for a total commitment of \$2,340?

**Pacesetter Gift** - We ask those who are in a position to give more, to pray and consider making a pacesetter gift of \$3,000 to \$20,000 to our Capital Fund to be given over the next three years.

**Leadership Gift** - We invite members who have been financially blessed to pray and consider making a leadership gift of \$20,000 or more to our Capital Fund to be given over the next three years.

#### Regular Weekly/Monthly Offerings

All parish members are asked to renew and grow their regular weekly/monthly offerings. As expenses continue to inch upwards, we recognize the need to consider the possibility of increasing our regular giving 2% to 3%. Keeping our regular giving strong allows us to keep touching hearts and lives with Christ's love through our many ministries. Our regular offerings remain our first priority in giving.
