GIFT Timeline of the Day

- At Home Activity
 - There is no login time for this portion. It is to be completed as a household at your convenience. Letter writing supplies and instructions were mailed out to each household this week!
- 12:00 – 12:30 pm (or earlier on your own time) Adult Video Presentation / Confirmation
 - Adults should not log on during this time. Instead, this time should be used to watch that week's video. If you have already done so, the time is yours to use as you choose!
 - Confirmation participants need to log on during this time using their Personal Meeting ID and Passcode listed below.
- 12:40 – 1:10 pm Adult Discussion / 9 & 10
 - Both groups need to log on using their respective Personal Meeting IDs and Passcodes which are listed below.
- 1:15 – 1:40 pm K4 & K5 / 7 & 8
 - Both groups need to log on using their respective Personal Meeting IDs and Passcodes which are listed below.
- 1:45 – 2:10 pm 1 & 2 / 5 & 6
 - Both groups need to log on using their respective Personal Meeting IDs and Passcodes which are listed below.
- 2:15 – 2:40 pm 3 & 4
 - 3rd and 4th grade participants need to log on using their Personal Meeting ID and Passcode listed below.
