

#### This Weekend—Trinity Sunday

Every time we make the sign of the cross, we invoke the Holy Trinity. While this is the bedrock of our faith, our understanding of the Trinity can be fuzzy. I often thought of the Trinity as a mystery and just left it at that. Such an important aspect of our faith, however, requires deeper thought.

Theologians have struggled over the centuries to capture an understanding of the Trinity. We are all familiar with St. Patrick's image of a clover. A quick search on the internet reveals images of God as an older man, Jesus as a younger man, and a dove hovering between them. In graduate school, I was taught about the Economic Trinity and the Immanent Trinity. If I looked back on my notes, I might formulate an understanding of those terms.

The image of the Trinity that I find most helpful is from St. Augustine. He had many attempts at this, but the most helpful for me is this: Lover...Beloved...Love.

The Father is the Lover, the Son is the Beloved, the Spirit is their Loving. It's all about love.

I think of my sixteenth birthday. Had I been Amish, I would have entered into "Rumspringa." It is a time of greater independence. Since I was Catholic, I continued to raise my siblings, went off to college, spent a year as a Catholic missionary, got married, and raised four children.

I've also wondered about Jesus's birthdays. We celebrate His birth on December 25. At age 12, He got in trouble with Mary and Joseph. He stayed behind to speak with the elders in the Temple. At age 30, He began the ministry of spreading the "Good News." At age 33, He would suffer, be crucified, die, be buried, rise from the dead, and return to his Father in Heaven. I am so happy He did this for us!

I met my wife, Elaine, as a Catholic missionary. Now we belong to this great Catholic community, Our Lady of Lourdes. If you are not a member of this parish, know that you all are welcome in this place!
