#### **Sacrament Preparation**

Is your child starting first grade this fall? Be ready for the sacraments of reconciliation and first Eucharist by enrolling in GIFT in August.

To be eligible for sacrament preparation the Archdiocese of Milwaukee requires that children be in religious formation one year prior to the year of sacrament reception. So, if your child was in 5-year-old kindergarten last school year, they need to participate in our formation program GIFT (Generations In Faith Together) during their first-grade year, so that they can celebrate the sacraments in second grade. Be sure to enroll in GIFT in August of 2023.


- Only new items; no perishables.

- Sales begin August 15, 2023, after select liturgies and continue throughout Oktoberfest weekend. Tickets will not be sold through the Parish Office.
- OLOL and the winner will split the jackpot equally.
- Check the website every Tuesday beginning August 22, 2023, for an update on the growing amount to win and other details.
- Parishioners are encouraged to sell tickets outside of Our Lady of Lourdes. Take tickets with you, gather the money and completed tickets, and return both together to the sales area after liturgies or at Oktoberfest.

#### Official rules

The winning ticket will be randomly drawn on Sunday, October 15, 2023, at 1:00 pm at Our Lady of Lourdes (OLOL) Oktoberfest in the Parish Hall. The winner does not need to be present to win. The winning number will be announced at Oktoberfest and will be posted on the OLOL website on Monday, October 16, 2023.

Only one person can be named on the ticket and only one winner will be awarded the prize.

The winner will have until October 30, 2023, to claim the prize and return all necessary paperwork to the OLOL Parish Office. If no one claims the prize by this date, another ticket will be drawn and announced on October 31, 2023, and this winner will have until November 14, 2023, to claim the prize by returning all the necessary paperwork to the OLOL Parish Office. If no one claims this prize, it will revert to OLOL.

Cash prize is determined by calculating half of net proceeds from the raffle sales. The remaining 50% will benefit OLOL Parish as it sees fit.

Participants must be 18 years or older to claim the prize.

All tickets transactions and winners associated with the 50/50 raffle are subject to state laws and the rules and regulations.

Applicable taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner. All winners will be required to provide OLOL with his/her social security number and a photo ID. Federal income tax withholding will be required for any prizes of more than \$5,000.

Cash prizes will be paid to the winner by check within 30 days from the date of paperwork being submitted.
