Sabbath

"To allow oneself to be carried away by a multitude of conflicting concerns, to surrender to too many demands, to commit oneself to too many projects, to want to help everyone in everything, is to succumb to a pervasive form of contemporary violence." (Thomas Merton)

Then Jesus said, "Let's go to a place where we can be alone and get some rest." (Mark 6:31 Contemporary English Version)

As this bulletin is being distributed, I am away from the parish with my family. Yes, it is a vacation, but it is very much an experience of Sabbath for us. Sabbath—from the Hebrew root meaning "cease" or "stop." In the following week we will walk on the beach, play board games, enjoy good food, and just rest.

Jesus' wisdom shines through in his invitation to the disciples—and to us—to go away and get some rest. It isn't healthy— spiritually, physically, or psychologically to continually push ourselves. The Missionary Cooperation Plan

The Missionary Cooperation Plan (MCP) was introduced in 1954 to the parishes in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Its purpose was to provide "a systematic method of furnishing each parish in the archdiocese with one missionary once a year." The director of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith (SPOF) was designated as the coordinator of the MCP. Then, as now, MCP has two primary purposes:

- To support missionary fundraising. When shared by all parishes, the Archdiocese is able to respond to mission group's monetary needs, without the burden falling solely on the Archdiocese or on only the largest or most well-funded parishes.
- 2) To ensure that all parishioners have their eyes and hearts open to the story of the global Church.

Each year our local SPOF partners with us for the annual MCP, offering an opportunity to encounter the global Church. For years OLOL has been able to foster our twinning relationship with Outreach to Haiti as our MCP mission. We have representatives speaking at all the Masses on August 12 and 13 to help us understand how our donations are being used to support our twinning relationship.
