## Endurance

Endurance is our ability to withstand adversity and hardship. We practice perseverance and patience when obstacles arise, open to the lessons they bring. We don't give up or feel hopeless about ourselves. We hold on. Endurance hones our character and seasons our souls. When trouble comes, endurance gives us the strength to stay the course.

In the Second Reading, which takes place some 70-90 years after Jesus' resurrection, early Christians were still waiting for the parousia. The writer of this reading says Jesus' prophecy is one we can rely on. What beliefs do you have that take perseverance in order to endure? What helps you to do so?
