Gerrymandering is a Social Justice Issue

Since America's founding, citizens have marched, fought, and died for the right to vote, guaranteed by the 15th Amendment. Nonetheless, laws are being proposed making it harder to vote disproportionately impacting the poor and people of color; however, there is a practice firmly in place, gerrymandering, that manipulates the boundaries of an electoral constituency to favor one party or class. In fact, "Wisconsin is home to some of the most extreme gerrymanders in the United States" (Princeton Gerrymandering Project). The USCCB recognized "...the importance of assuring the integrity of elections processes..." in their June 2021 letter to Congress. Gerrymandering definitely compromises this integrity. Candidates who support your beliefs and values may be predetermined to lose.


