NOTES FROM DEB

A Few Thoughts on the Gospel for Today

My time in graduate school at Loyola University was fruitful. I learned wonderful aspects of our faith, scripture, and the life of Jesus. One of the things that stuck with me was the idea that Jesus as a human being—like us in all things but sin—had a first century human consciousness as well. Jesus did not have it all figured out. He had to grow and mature and discern his vocation.

Our Gospel today seems to bear out what my professor was saying. Jesus had been focusing his message on the Jews—the lost people of Israel. This unnamed woman, driven by the strongest force in the universe, a mother's love, helps Jesus to understand that he was to move beyond his own people, beyond what he was expecting to do, to minister to all people.

Jesus' task is our task too. It is upon all of us to discern where God is calling each of us. While most of us adults have answered the big questions (i.e., marriage, single life, religious life etc.), God's call to us is ongoing and unique to each of us. My prayer is that we all come to understand where we are being led as disciples of Jesus Christ, and that we find the courage and strength to follow that call.
