### **NOTES FROM DEB**

### A Good Time to Reflect on the Eucharist

As you know, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops have called a multiyear Eucharistic Revival. While we will be focusing on the Eucharist in much of our programming at the parish this year, I think it is important to look individually at our own hearts and beliefs about the Eucharist. This is a good time to do just that.

Some questions that might guide our reflections:

- The term "Eucharist" originates from the Greek "eucharistia" which means thanksgiving. Am I able to connect receiving the Eucharist with a sense of gratitude?
- For several months in 2020, the parish was closed because of the
  coronavirus pandemic. No one was receiving the Eucharist (except for Fr.
  Bill who was recording Mass in his basement!). Did that time change how
  I viewed the Eucharist? Did missing receiving Communion get easier or
  harder as the pandemic dragged on?
- In my heart of hearts, what do I believe about the Eucharist. How has my understanding of the Eucharist changed over the years?
- St. Augustine said that in receiving the Eucharist, we become what we receive. In the parish we are speaking a lot about being Eucharist for the world. Does that make sense?

Understanding the Eucharist is our lifelong Christian task. I certainly do not have all the answers, but I am grateful to be on this journey with all of you. Your shepherd,


