If you decide to attend, please let Roxanne know in the office by November 1.

Our faith gives us the assurance that those who have died are in the arms of our God—our God whose forgiveness has no bounds, whose love is beyond anything we can imagine. Even though we believe that, losing someone we love is still painful. The burden of grief is lessened when we share it with one another. On the first and third Saturdays of every month, we have an opportunity to do just that with our Walking Through Grief Together group. All are welcome to attend.

May we continue to be inspired by the saints, near and far, who have gone before us.
