#### **Cancellation and Closing Notifications**

Since we just had over a week of Wisconsin winter weather, let's visit one more time how best to learn about cancellations and closing the parish due to bad weather.

First alerts will go out through our **app and text notifications**. If you miss the notification on our app, open the app and check "Messages" located on the menu bar at the bottom of the screen. You will find a copy of all notifications that we have sent out.

Then postings will go up on our **website home page and Facebook.** If you are having trouble finding "Messages" or they are not loading properly, you can access our website from the app to see the cancellation posting.

Lastly, the **local TV stations** will be contacted. This order is based on the speed and ease (fastest to slowest) of disseminating the information.

We are aware that not everyone has a smartphone or tablet, so we will continue to use every means necessary to alert people about closings and cancellations. If you do have a smartphone or tablet, we encourage you to download our app.

Even if we are open in bad weather, please use your best judgement and stay home if that is what you are most comfortable with.
