

Since October 2021, the Church has been engaged in the process of preparation for the Synod of Bishops. The first Synod session was held in October 2023, and the next session will be held in October of this year.

In this interim time, dioceses around the world are holding listening sessions focused on questions about the Church's structure and mission. Specifically, we will be asked to reflect on the following questions:

- Where have I seen or experienced successes—and distresses—within the Church's structure(s)/organization/leadership/life that encourage or hinder the mission?
- How can the structures and organization of the Church help all the baptized to respond to the call to proclaim the Gospel and to live as a community of love and mercy in Christ?

This is a big deal—and the bishops want to hear from you!

Good Friday Guided Meditation

The Stations of the Cross is an ancient meditative pilgrimage inviting the spiritually hungry to walk the "Way of Sorrows" with Jesus to his death on Calvary hill. Traditionally depicted in fourteen visuals, the Stations highlight pivotal moments in Jesus' final hours. At 12:00 pm on Friday, March 29, participants will choose to participate in either a guided meditation or an art walk of Lauren Wright Pittman's graphic art rendition of the Stations to imagine Jesus' journey toward crucifixion through a modern lens. In conjunction with a companion guide, these 12 stripped down and textured black and white images highlight the metaphorical and emotional layers of Jesus' journey toward his last breaths.

Social Justice: An Invitation



Tech Terms and Tips

Internet: A globally connected massive computer network system.

World Wide Web (WWW or the web): A system of Internet servers that is made from millions of interlinked websites and web pages.

Browser: The software used to find information on the Web. Examples are Google Chrome or Microsoft Internet Explorer.

Address bar: The narrow, rectangular box on the topmost part of a browser window where you can type in a web address.
