Tech Terms and Tips Why is it important to keep up-todate on updates to your operating system and hardware?

Operating system (OS) updates provide fixes to possible bugs and security holes, along with cleaning up outdated software. Updating to the latest OS version guards against cybersecurity issues.

Beyond the OS, your devices also require updates to items such as service packs, and drivers, to insure the security and reliability of your computer, tablet, or phone. They offer the latest protection against malicious online activities.

Often your device will alert you to an update. It is important to address those in a timely fashion or set your devices to run updates automatically.
