

NOTES FROM DEB

A few thoughts about today's Gospel.

"I am the vine, you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit," John 15:5

I love this image of the vine and the branches because it shows us how very connected we are with Jesus. Jesus is telling us that as there is no separation between the vine and its branches, there is no separation between Jesus' life and ours. Our very life and breath are an extension of the divine. Jesus' life is within us and a part of us.

That is quite a concept to hold in our minds and in our hearts. For many of us it is more familiar to envision Jesus far removed from us—in the heaven we hope for and the Eucharist we consume.

As "branches" of Christ's life, I invite you to think of the "fruit" that you bear. Think about the love that you share, the acts of tenderness, the many ways you serve others, from donating to our food pantry, to caring for loved ones who are ill, to listening to someone who needs to talk. All of these things, and so much more, are the fruits that we bear for the world because of our connection to Jesus our Christ.

May we all know our connectedness to our God and may we continue bearing the fruit that feeds our hungry world.

SOCIAL TEACHING

Today we hear the metaphor of the vine and branches. Jesus tells his disciples that he is the vine, his Father is the vine grower, and we are the branches. This metaphor gives an image of a caretaker watering, pruning, and checking regularly on his crop. It is interesting that Jesus and his followers are part of the same plant, growing together and cared for by the Father. The Father cares for the vine, the vine cares for the branches, and the branches produce fruit.

What is the fruit which we, the branches, are being called to produce? Do we produce for ourselves or for others? If the Father cares tenderly for the vine and the vine cares tenderly for us, we must produce fruit that cares tenderly for others.

Safe Environment Week: Did you know?

Safe Environment Week may be coming to a close, but there is still more to know about the program. The Archdiocese of Milwaukee has a Victim Assistance Coordinator that assists survivors of sexual abuse to navigate through the process of reporting abuse and receiving counselling services. The Victim Assistance Coordinator can be reached at (414) 758-2232.

The Archdiocese of Milwaukee also has a third-party reporting mechanism for misconduct through Convercent. All mandatory reporting laws in the State of Wisconsin are required to be followed with all reports to the Archdiocese of Milwaukee or Convercent. A report of abuse can also be made through the Advocate Aurora Healing Center or directly reported to the appropriate civil authorities.

Vine & Branches

Today's passage from John's Gospel recalls the wisdom Jesus shared during his last meal with the disciples. Jesus tells the disciples: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower." Their followers, then and now, are the branches.

What do these images say about the Christian community? The people of God are all of great value. Branches in a vine mix with each other such that it can be difficult to tell when one branch starts and another ends. So too are our lives

interconnected with one another. We cannot be church alone. Further, the Christian community gains its energy from Christ the Vine. Like branches need a strong vine in order to bear fruit, so too does the Christian community need the spirit of Christ in order to bear fruits of service in the world.

From St. Vincent de Paul


